This year, two in five Canadians — possibly your parents, children or friends — will be diagnosed with cancer.

It is a disease that has an impact on each of our lives because cancer is the leading cause of death in Canada.

When we consider our role in the fight for life, a key question comes to mind — **have we made a difference?** Have over 70 years of funding research, sharing information and supporting Canadians made an impact against this disease?

The answer is yes.

British Columbians have the lowest overall incidence of cancer diagnoses and deaths because of excellent cancer care and healthy lifestyles. Fortunately cancer treatments and the quality of life during treatment have dramatically improved in the past 20 years.

However, as we look to the future, due to our growing and aging population, there will be more new cancer cases diagnosed each year.

We are with you in this fight because, together, we can do more. The Canadian Cancer Society has more impact against more cancers in more communities than any other cancer charity.

Our impact comes from leading crucial cancer prevention initiatives, funding lifesaving research into all cancers and delivering trusted information and compassionate support to people living with cancer and their caregivers.

We are focused on critical prevention programs that help Canadians reduce their risk of cancer. As we move forward with the innovative Cancer Prevention Centre in partnership with UBC, we will take a leadership role in planning and executing a national strategy for cancer prevention.



GIVING: Annual events

Coquitlam *Relay For Life* was one of 49 events across BC and the Yukon.

Our continued investment in lifesaving research is bringing us closer than ever to fully understanding, treating and preventing cancer. Pioneering researchers like Dr Raymond Andersen, who is looking to the ocean as a rich and diverse source of inspiration for cancer treatments, are leading a wave of breakthroughs in our fight against the disease. And, Dr Carolyn Gotay, Director of the Cancer Prevention Centre at UBC whose team is spearheading prevention investigations and putting them to practice.

In 2011, we celebrated some significant milestones in our efforts to support cancer patients and their families. Our Cancer Information Service, a bilingual, toll-free service that provides personalized, comprehensive and reliable information and resources about cancer, answered its one millionth inquiry. We also broke ground on the Kordyban Lodge — a new accommodation facility for cancer patients in Northern BC.

We are deeply grateful to our vast network of volunteers, partners, donors and supporters who keep us connected to communities across BC and the Yukon and empower us every day to lead the fight for life, to reduce the impact of cancer and to work together toward the day no one will hear the words “you have cancer”.

What are we doing to help you prevent cancer?

About half of all cancers can be prevented through healthy living and policies that protect the health of Canadians.

That's why we're working hard to help you prevent cancer by:

- Funding innovative research to understand more about how the disease develops and how we can stop it before it starts
- Undertaking health education to empower you to protect your health
- Advocating to government to pass public policies that will reduce risk
- Encouraging community action to create social and political change to help control cancer

Prevention Research Highlights

- Research shows that shift work exposing women to light at night is a breast cancer risk factor. We are funding a study that evaluates the impact of a sleep program on sleep quality and factors related to breast cancer risk, including lifestyle and biological markers.

- The Cancer Prevention Centre, led by Dr Carolyn Gotay, Chair of Cancer Primary Prevention and founded in partnership with UBC, is laying the groundwork for the future of cancer prevention in Canada. The Centre will attract world class researchers and work with community partners to translate research into practice.

PREVENTION IN ACTION: Local company takes on innovative health program to promote wellness in the workplace

Doug Thompson (left) and Owen Carney (right) of Carney's Waste Systems, a Squamish waste management solutions company with 70 employees, participated in the pilot workplace wellness program, WellnessFits. The program provides employers with good health resources they can share with their employees. Carney's completed the healthy eating and physical activity challenges successfully. The company has since implemented three new policies to support staff in making healthy choices.

Education, Advocacy and Community Engagement Highlights

Our approach to educate, advocate and engage communities is a winning combination in prevention.

- Our Tan-Free Grad Challenge encouraged secondary school students across BC to fight back against skin cancer by foregoing the "prom tan". In its first year, 21 high schools participated with an 80% pledge rate among Grade 12 students.
- We completed the development of a comprehensive workplace wellness program pilot in 14 work sites designed to provide tools and support for employers dedicated to improving the health of their employees.
- Breast Screening Saves Lives, a successful pilot program working with South Asian women in the Fraser Valley, engaged beauticians and doctors to raise awareness of breast cancer screening guidelines.

- Our successful lobbying efforts contributed to the BC government's decision to make nicotine replacement therapies (NRT) available at no cost to British Columbians trying to quit smoking. More than 63,000 British Columbians have registered for NRT.
- BC and Yukon had many initiatives to support the introduction of province-wide legislation banning the use and sale of cosmetic pesticides.
- We advocated with a strong presence at the Union of BC Municipalities Convention on the need to ban youth under 18 from using indoor tanning equipment and laid the groundwork for legislation.
- Men and women across the province were encouraged to "get a game plan" when we launched a prevention awareness initiative in the fall.

RESEARCH: Searching the world's oceans for cures

Cancer researcher **Dr Raymond Andersen**, a professor in chemical and geochemical oceanography at UBC, has been developing anticancer drugs based on substances from sea animals for many years. Because sea creatures use toxic substances to repel predators, these characteristics can be used as the basis for developing chemicals that can kill cancer cells.

Dr Andersen was awarded a \$420,000 grant (2011 – 2013) from the Canadian Cancer Society Research Institute to continue his investigations.

What are we doing to save lives?

The Canadian Cancer Society is the only organization in Canada that funds all types of research into all forms of cancer.

Cancer research saves lives. We fund research that generates knowledge about the biology of cancer, early detection and diagnosis, screening, treatment and advanced care. We also focus on quality of life issues throughout and beyond the cancer journey. Prevention research explores the causes of cancer, risk factors and the impact of behaviour changes.

We are closer than ever before to fully understanding cancer. The range of research funded by the Canadian Cancer Society has contributed to our current knowledge of the disease. And as our knowledge increases, we will see even greater progress in the fight for life.

Research Highlights

- With improvements in cancer survival rates, there are a growing number of cancer survivors, many of whom will face new risks related to their health. Dr Winson Cheung of the BC Cancer Agency is leading the first large-scale study of its kind to investigate whether adult cancer survivors are receiving appropriate preventative care. The results of this work will inform the development of future health policies and programs.
- Three UBC researchers were also funded in 2011. Dr Gang Li is investigating the molecular mechanisms that lead to melanoma and Dr Lawrence McIntosh focuses on the processes that 'turn on' genes. (See Dr Andersen, photo left)
- The Canadian Cancer Society invests in clinical trials that directly impact the way cancer is treated today. Here in BC, approximately 252 new patients were enrolled in 28 clinical trials in 2011.

How are we improving the lives of people living with cancer?

By helping them get informed, feel supported and be empowered.

In 2011, an estimated 22,220 people in BC and the Yukon were diagnosed with cancer. Feeling scared, overwhelmed and confused, many of them turned to the Canadian Cancer Society for information, assistance and emotional support.

Support Highlights

- More than 7,100 people in BC and the Yukon received reliable information from supportive Cancer Information Service specialists in 2011.
- Camp Goodtimes provided fun, empowering and memorable summer recreation programs to more than 500 children with cancer and their families. "It is a wonderful, whole other world," said one parent.
- About 4,500 clients used the convenient, complimentary transportation service to get them to cancer treatments. The service is provided by volunteer drivers from the Canadian Cancer Society and the Freemasons.
- We launched a safe, confidential online community, cancerconnection.ca which connected 4,700 patients, survivors, and caregivers in BC and the Yukon.
- There were 6,000 admissions to our welcoming, affordable and comfortable lodges in Vancouver, Kelowna and Victoria, where we provide a 'home away from home' to those who must travel to cancer treatment centres.
- Following a highly successful fundraising campaign and a generous \$2 million grant from the BC Ministry of Health, BC and Yukon began construction of a new accommodation facility, the Korbyban Lodge, for cancer patients in Northern BC.
- More than 800 people facing cancer were supported by a CancerConnection match to a survivor with a similar cancer experience, such as Rukhshana Daroowala. (photo right)
- The financial assistance program helped 630 people in need with their travel and accommodation expenses during treatment.

From cancer survivor to thrivor

Rukhshana Daroowala of North Vancouver survived advanced stomach cancer against the odds. At the time, she didn't know about the Society's CancerConnection matching program. Now, 11 years later, she is a trained volunteer who helps countless people across Canada who have been diagnosed with stomach cancer. Rukhshana has found the experiences enriching and incredibly therapeutic.

How do you fund the fight for life?

Our donors give courageously because they know a donation to the Canadian Cancer Society is the best investment in the cancer cause.

Giving Highlights

- Thanks to the continued generosity of our donors, our gross fundraising revenue in 2011 was \$34.4 million, which included \$6.9 million raised through a capital campaign to build the Kordyban Lodge in Prince George.
- Our national signature event, the unique and moving *Relay For Life* is the biggest event making the biggest impact in the fight against cancer. *Relay For Life* brings together cancer survivors, community members and all those whose lives who have been touched by cancer. In 2011, 49 *Relay For Life* events in BC raised \$5.2 million in gross revenue.

- Each fall more than a hundred members of law enforcement and emergency services cycle across four regions of British Columbia. Every kilometre pedaled in the Cops for Cancer bike tours helped raise funds totaling \$2.6 million in gross revenue.

- The Canadian Cancer Society hosts a variety of special events that build community spirit and raise funds, including our Daffodil Ball galas in Vancouver and Kelowna. We also benefit from the support of independently planned events, including the Asian Giving campaigns and the Ride2Survive, all of which brought in \$3 million.

- Our donors contributed \$8.4 million to our traditional Daffodil Campaign, corporate and employee giving and other annual programs.

- Planned gifts of \$6.7 million were received in 2011 with a total of \$42 million in commitments of future legacies to the Planned Gift Registry.

We are tremendously grateful to each and every resident of BC and the Yukon who have joined us in the fight for life.

How are you, our volunteers, helping us in the fight for life?

Our passionate volunteers lend their hands and hearts in the fight against cancer.

Our volunteers are in leadership roles as Community Ambassadors, *Relay For Life* Co-Chairs, Daffodil Street Team Captains and Volunteer Engagement Support Team Leaders. They are also active fundraisers and event planners, deliver support, prevention and advocacy programs and assist in many aspects of regional operations.

Volunteer Highlights

- Over 150 leadership volunteers participated in the BC and Yukon Workforce Leadership program designed to help staff and volunteers enhance their skills including coaching for performance, collaboration and inspiring teams.
- Fifty one BC and Yukon volunteers were recognized in 2011 for their accomplishments and contribution to our mission. They received 15 National Awards (12 individual and 3 team honours) representing over 30% of all National Awards distributed. The Kordyban Lodge Cabinet received the Circle of Distinction award for leading the capital campaign which raised \$6.9 million in 2011.



VOLUNTEERS: Our greatest resource

Over 6,000 dedicated volunteers joined us during Daffodil Month to raise awareness and to help raise \$2.4 million.

- We engaged students from 21 high schools in our advocacy initiative, Tanning is Out, which focuses on the dangers of UV radiation. The exposure generated by this initiative strengthened our advocacy efforts for province-wide legislation.
